

September 2023

LEED for Operations and Maintenance (O+M) draft released at Greenbuild

April 2024

First public comment period opens

Public comment period(s)

Rating system refinement

Ballot and member ratification

Early 2025


Rating system opens for registration

Entirety of 2024

LEED 0+M beta LEED for Building Design and Construction (BD+C) and Interior Design and Construction (ID+C) will proceed without a beta

Distribution of Public Comments

5.356 comments have been submitted to the USGBC from around the world.



Comments – high level summary

- Most comments aim on more technical clarity (LEED Rating System vs. LEED Reference Guide)
- A lot of comments share a similar intent; the detailed suggestions vary.
- Approx. 6% of currently reviewed comments are from European stakeholders.
- Limited amount of comments which directly address the EU Taxonomy.

Comments – next steps

- Rating system will be revised based on major comments per credit category.
- A second round of public comments will follow in late summer/fall.
- Based on the received comments further technical guidance will be developed as basis for the LEED Reference Guide.
- Further technical guidance will also include European specific content either as part of the credits or through ACPs (EU Taxonomy, F-Gas regulation,...).

Top 3: Location & Transportation

- More alternative transportation modes should be added to better reflect site and location specific circumstances.
- Focus only on electric vehicles is questioned. What about hydrogen, etc.?

How about using WalkScore in Europe?

Top 3: Water Efficiency

- Should points for project without water towers be awarded?
- Credit language still unclear if water sense is required outside US.
- EnergyStar appliances hard to procure outside US (e.g. dishwashers, icemakers)

Discussion:

Should EU Taxonomy thresholds be used for European project?

Top 3: Energy & Atmosphere

- How is district energy treated in decarb planning and modelling?
- How are biobased fuels (e.g. wood?) treated?
- Envelope testing requirement suitable for all projects?.
- Is Minimum Energy Efficiency too stringent or not ambitious enough?

Discussion:

Should the European F-Gas Regulation be the baseline for the refrigerant credits in Europe?

Top 3: Materials & Resources

- LCA more clarity on baseline building is requested.
- Low-emitting-materials: too much effort for the number of points awarded?
- Should construction and demolition waste be more prominent?

Discussion:

How can LEED better support the concept "LCA as a design tool"?

Top 3: Indoor Environmental Quality

- Building Accessibility Should rather local code/standards be relevant for the credit?
- All other comments on this section are currently rather considered as "minor" and not specific to Europe.
